- NC State is the only facility in the Carolinas with MRI capabilities for the large animal.
- NC State has the most technically advanced endoscope on the East Coast, improving our ability to diagnose upper GI disease in the horse.
- NC State is the worldwide leader in equine ophthalmology, including pioneering the first sight-saving cyclosporine implant for the treatment of equine recurrent uveitis, the leading cause of blindness in the horse.
- NC State is the only university in the Southeast with a team of specialists in equine sports medicine and rehabilitation.
- NC State is the only veterinary hospital on the East Coast to use advanced MRI and ultrasound techniques to precisely provide regenerative therapies to injured areas.
- NC State is the only regional source of specialized reproductive services in the state.
- NC State is the only university in the United States performing stem cell research for the treatment of orthopedic, gastrointestinal and ophthalmologic injuries and diseases.
- Laser surgery for horses started at NC State and continues to be an area of innovation.
